19th Homeless Connect Edmonton opens doors

People who are experiencing homelessness or who are at risk of becoming homeless will access a variety of essential and dignity enhancing services on one day, at one location Sunday, October 15, at Shaw Conference Centre.

More than 350 community volunteers and 70 service providers will be on site to provide health care, counselling, legal services, employment and training information, housing resources, and much more to help end homelessness in Edmonton.
